Ludo (board game)

Ludo is a strategy board game for two to four players, in which the players race their four *tokens* from start to finish according to the rolls of a single **die**. Like other cross and circle games, Ludo is derived from the Indian game Pachisi, but simpler.

This event divided into three rounds:

- 1) All the participants were divided into four-four groups and were made to play.
- 2) From each group one winner was taken which was again made to play with the other winner player.
- 3) After playing all the rounds we got four finalists who played the final round and one winner and runner up was decided.
