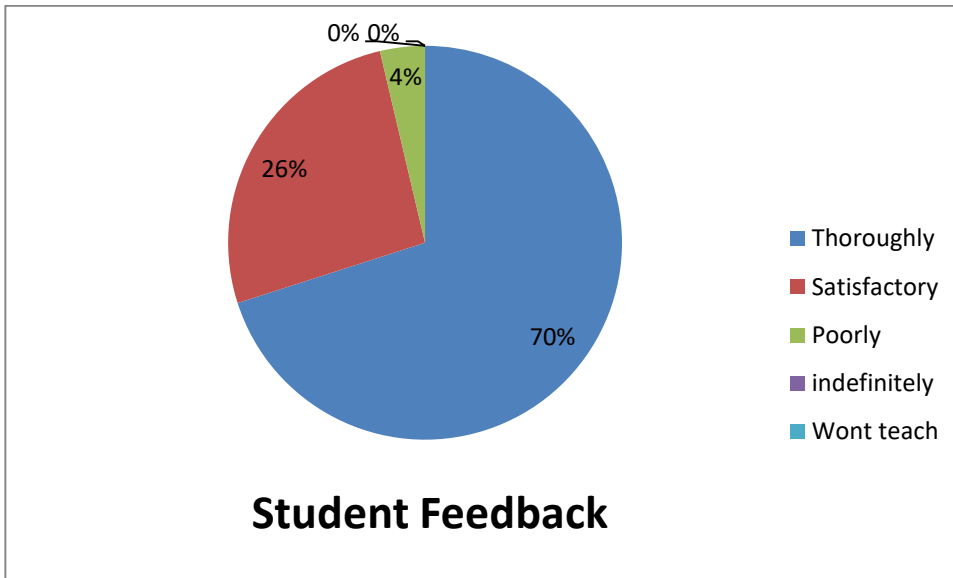
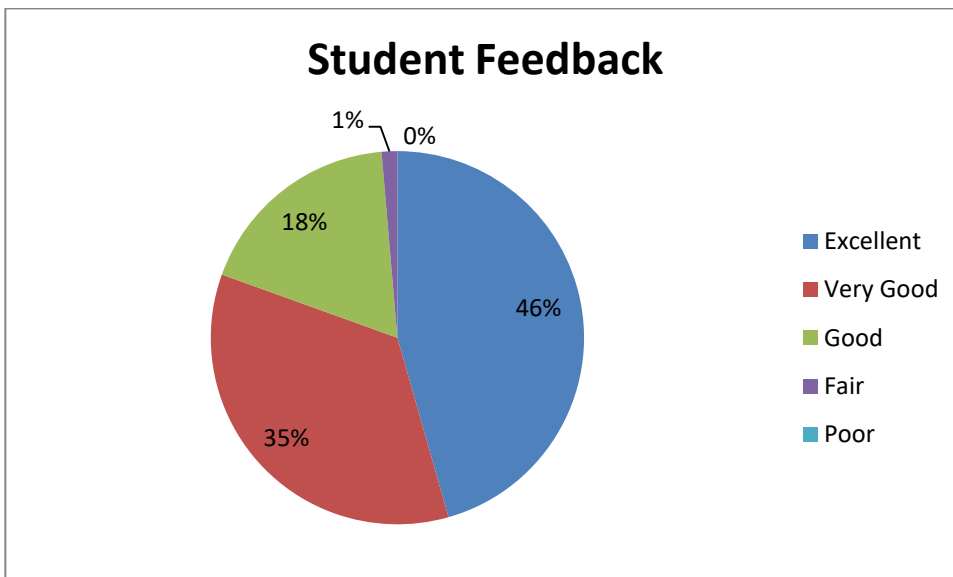

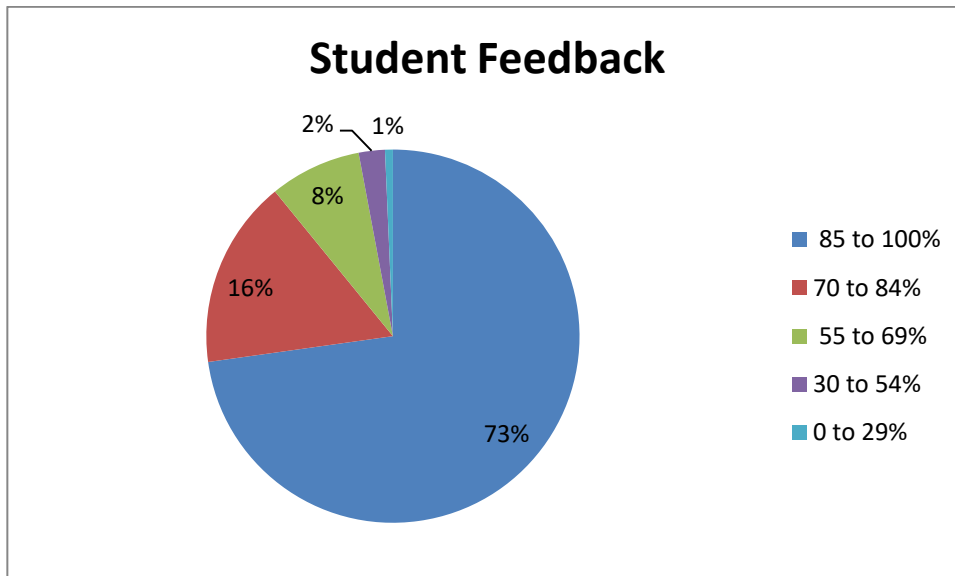


Q.2 The teacher's approach to teaching can be best described as

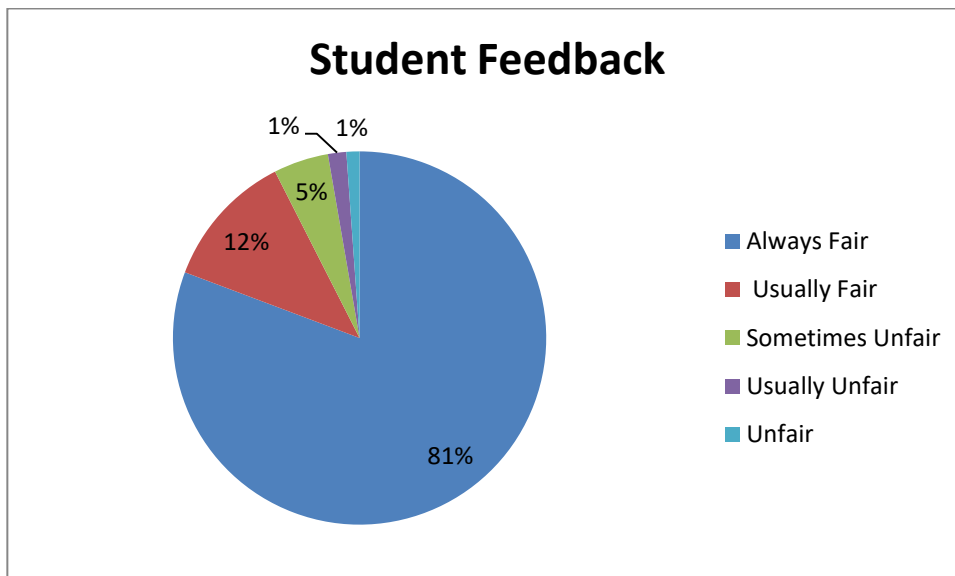

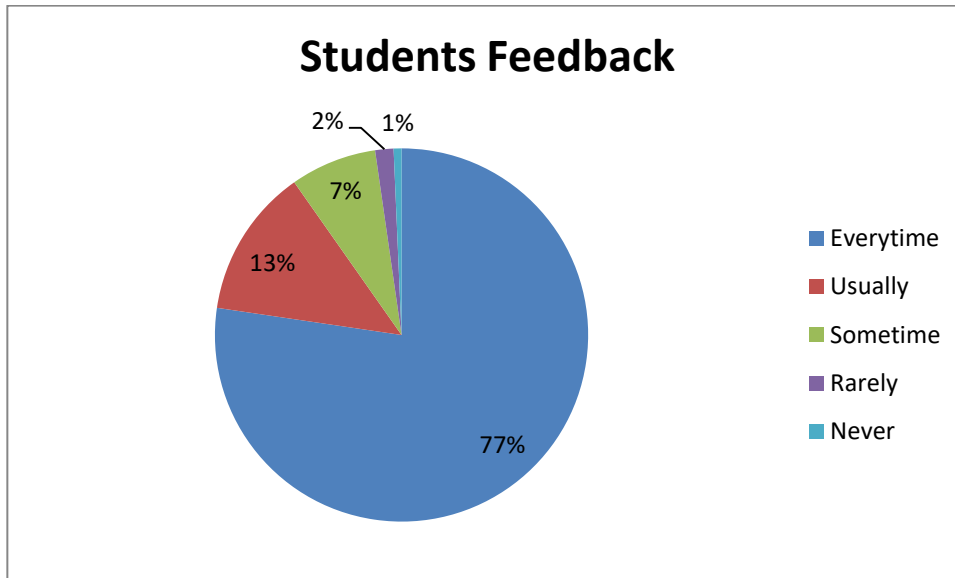

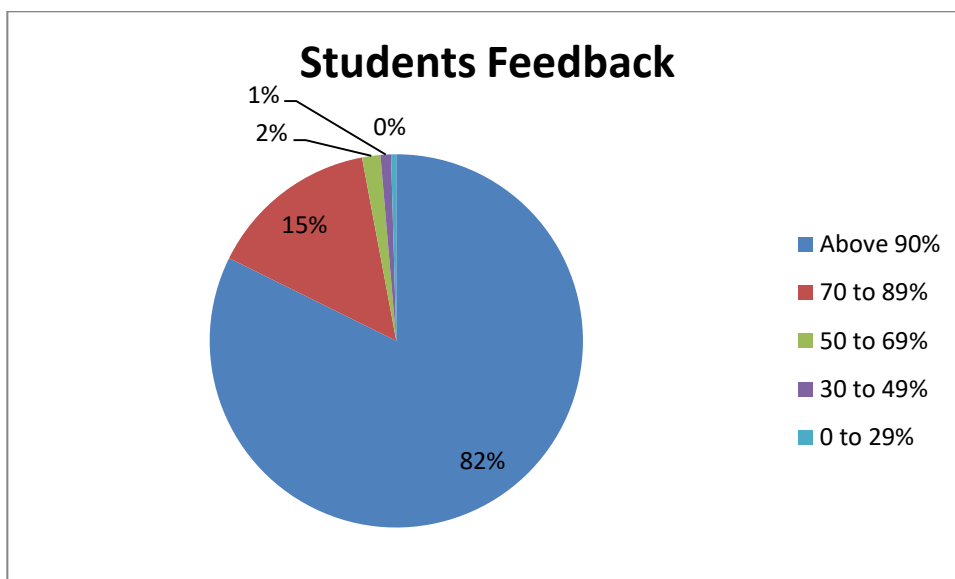

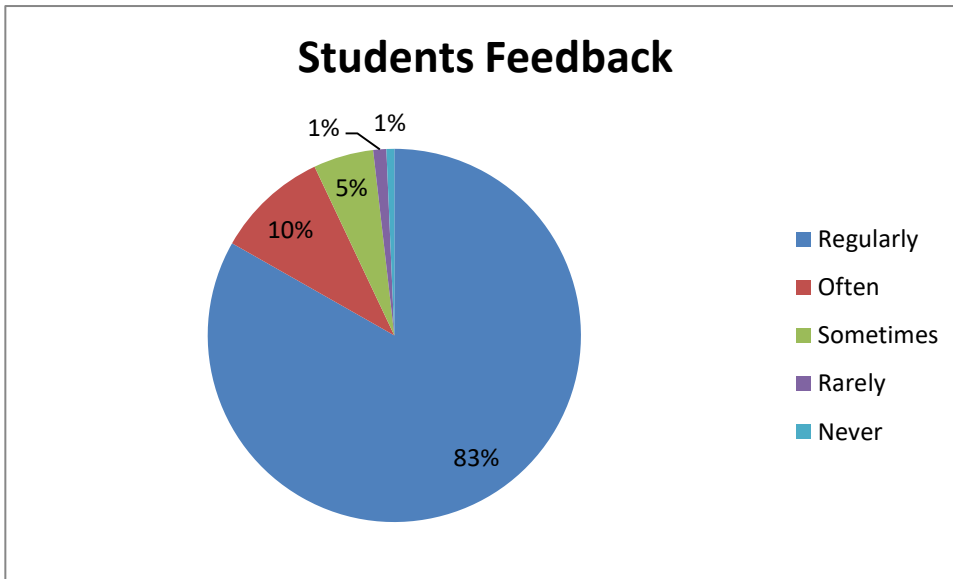


Q.6 What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?

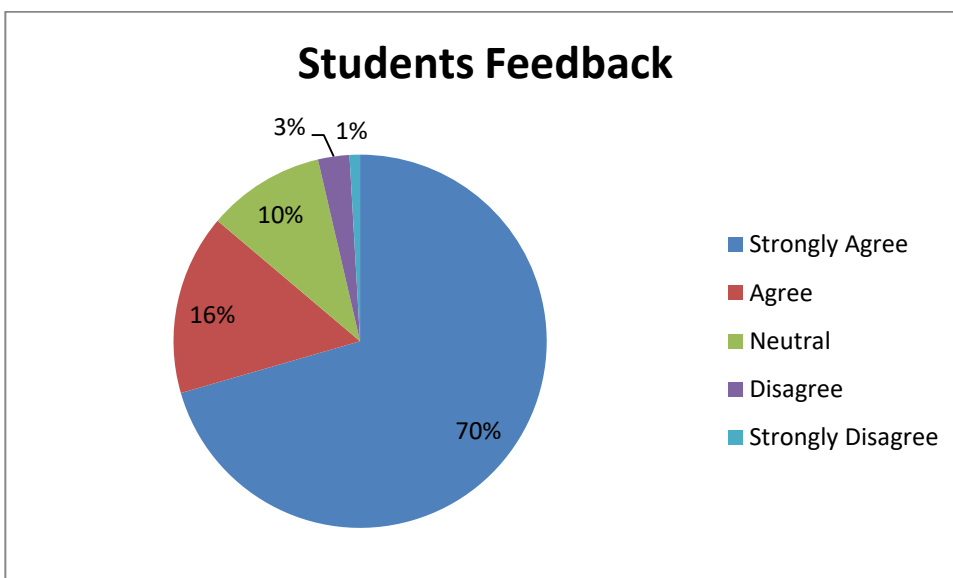

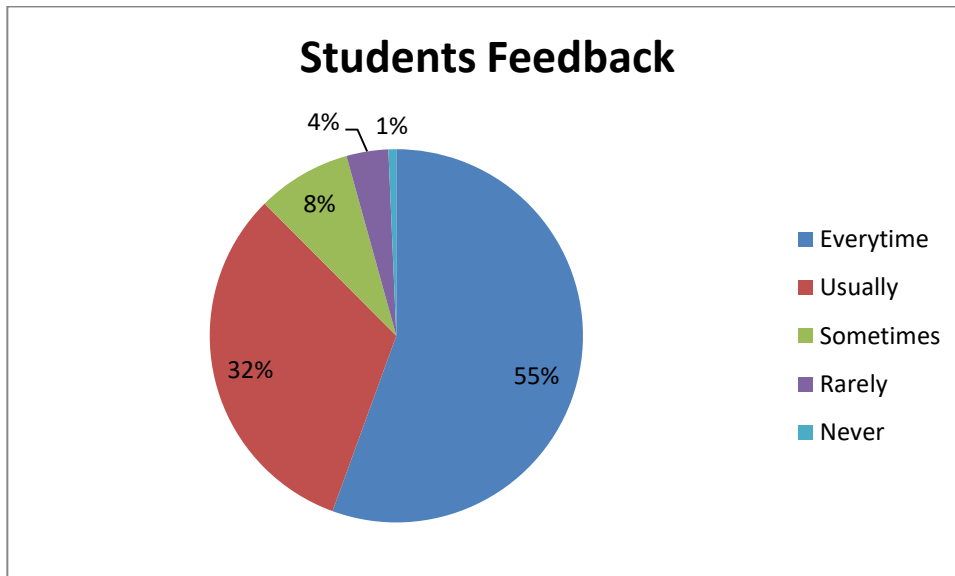

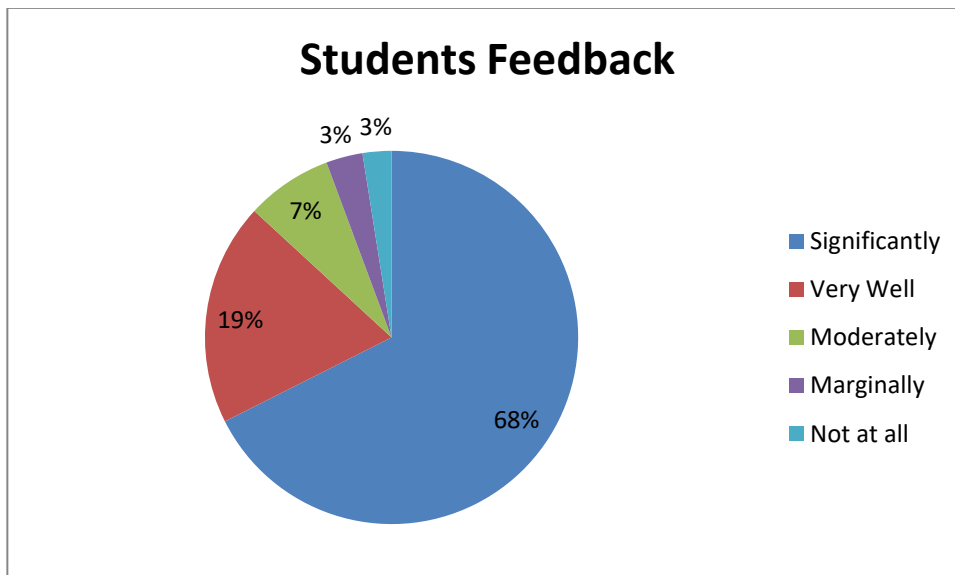

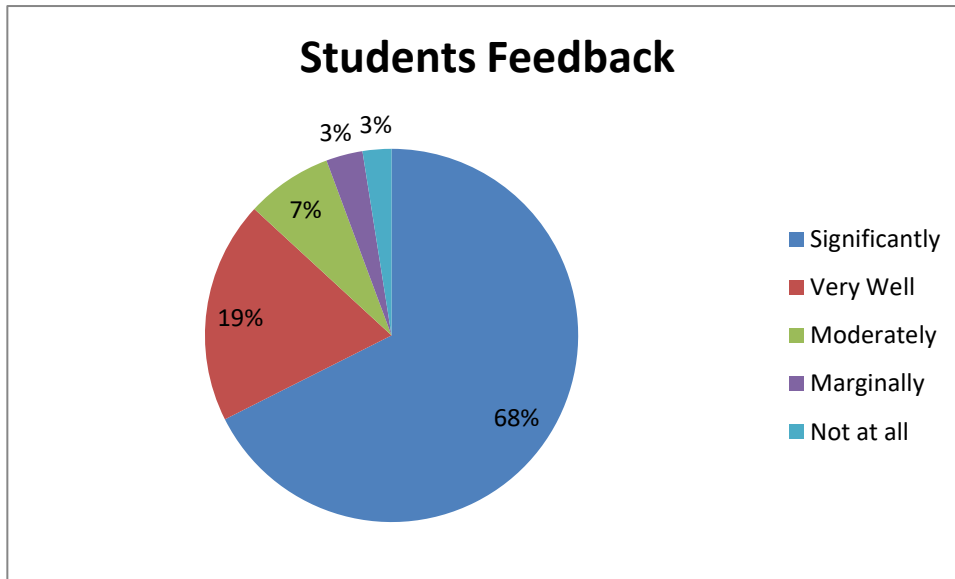

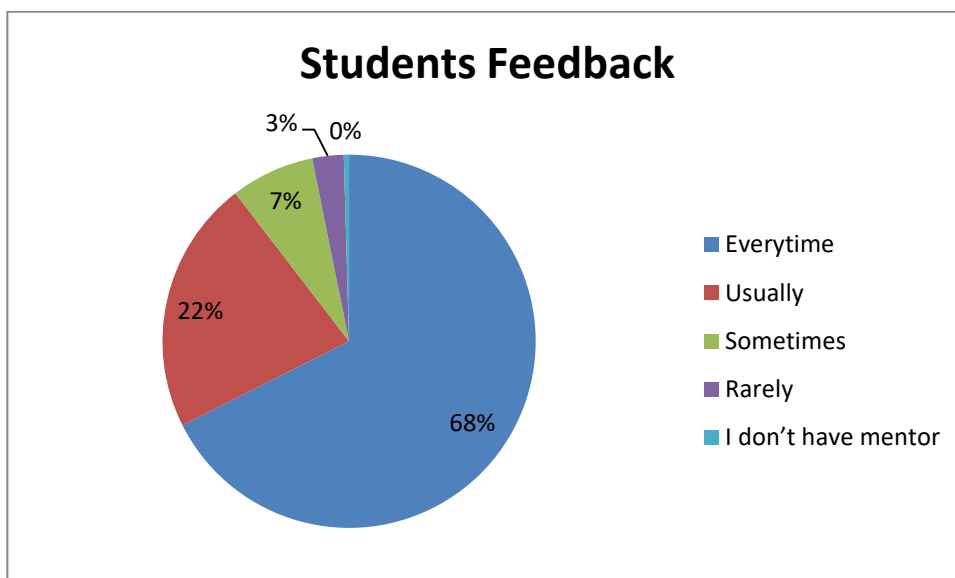

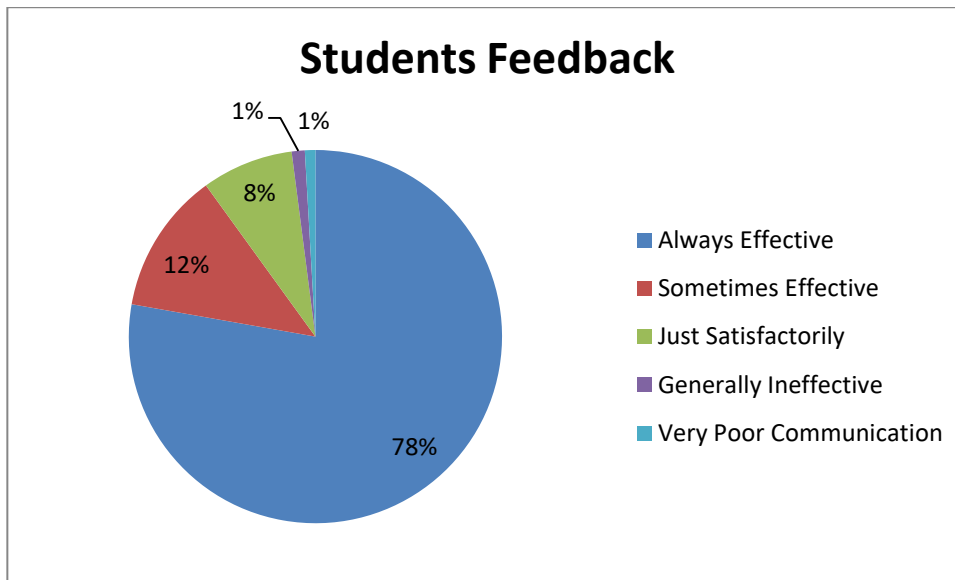

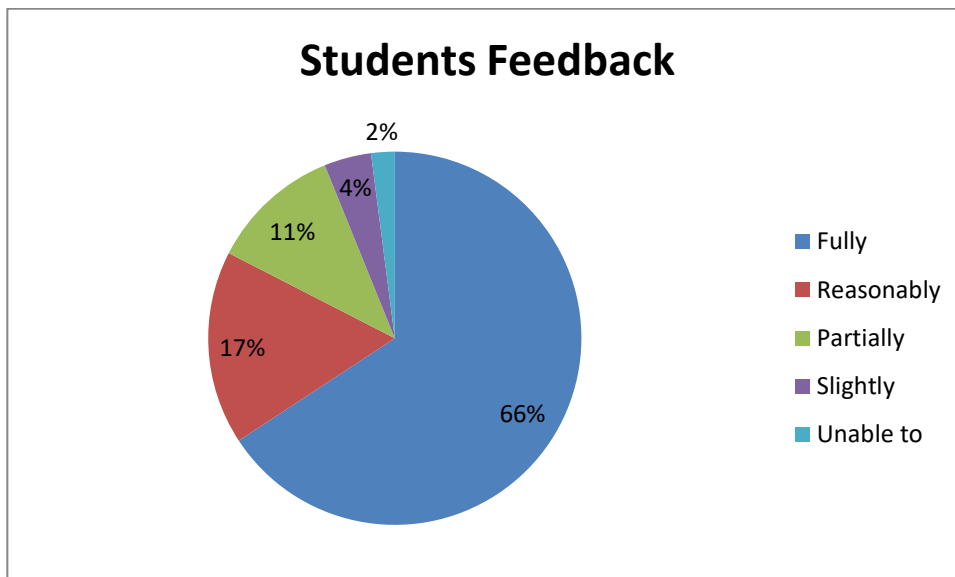

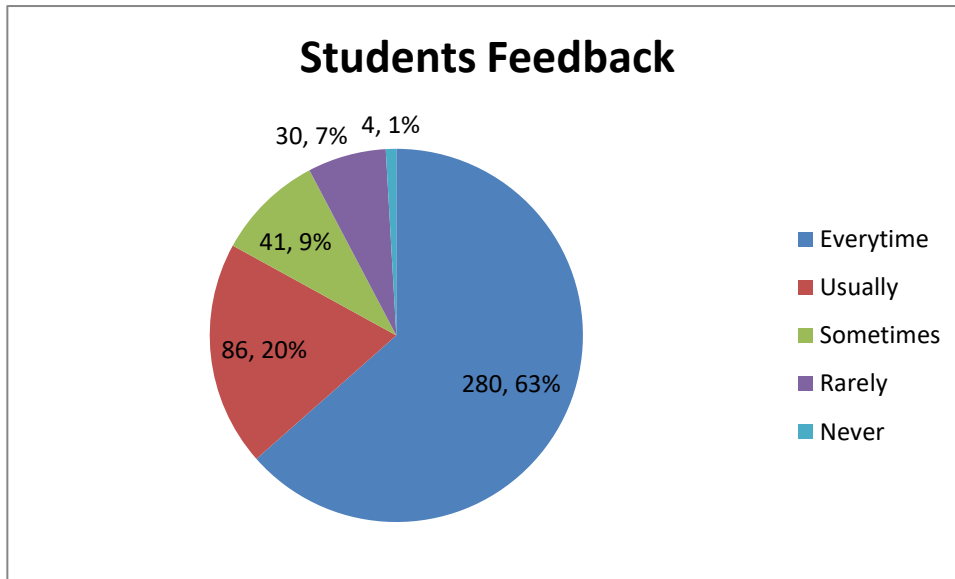

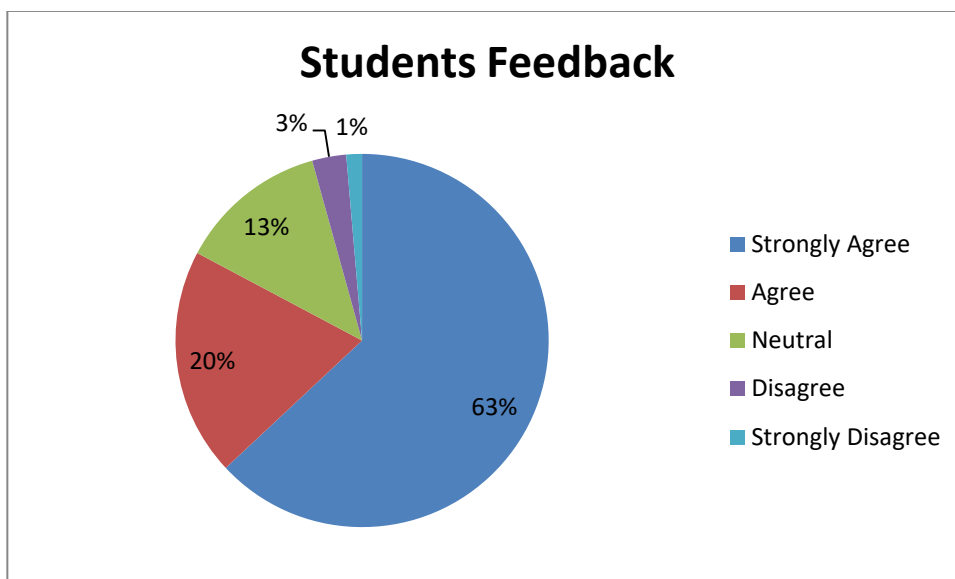

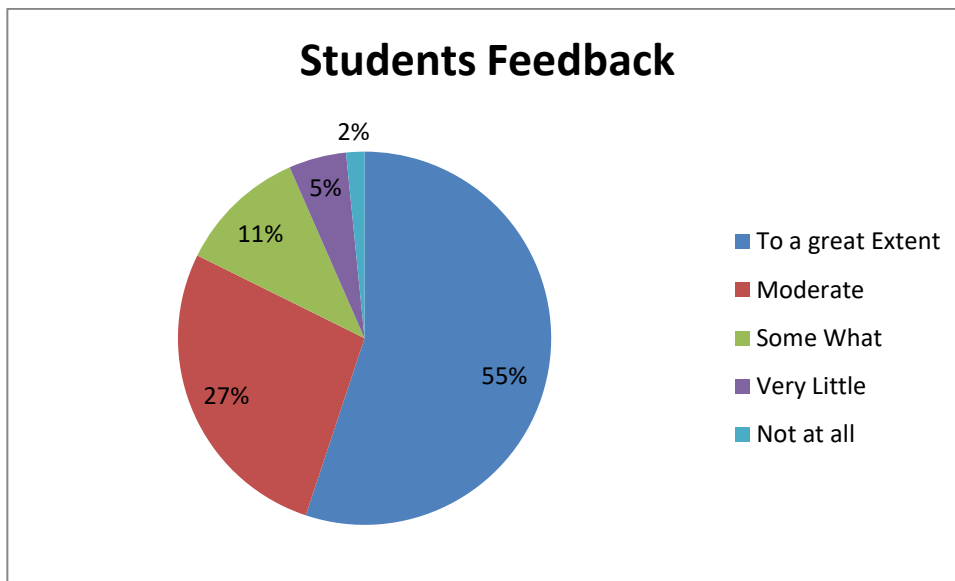

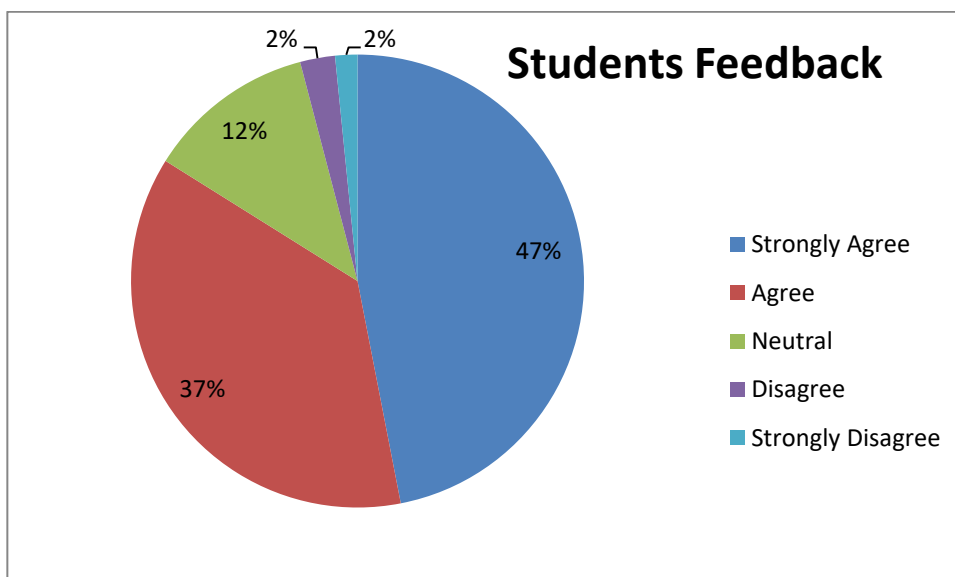

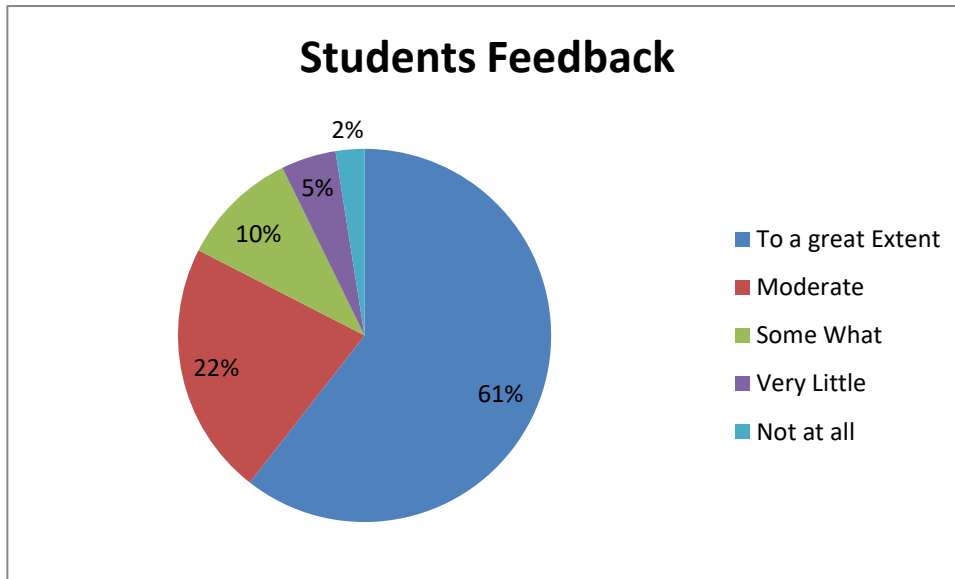
