NAAC Orientation program was held on 15th April 2023 between 10.30 am to 4.00pm in the Department of Computer Engineering, Seminar Hall in view of the preparation for NAAC reaccreditation process of the college for Academic Year 2023 -24.

Dr. K.C. Shirsath , IQAC Head , NAAC Co-ordinator , Head Dept. of Computer Engineering , Sandip Foundation of Engineering & Management , Nashik, gave an introduction to the process of Assessment and Accreditation (A&A) with focus on the following theme.

Assessment: Performance evaluation of an institution or its units based on certain established criteria.

Accreditation: Certification of quality that is valid for a fixed period, which in the case of NAAC is five years NAAC assessment lays focus on the institutional quality culture with reference to three aspects: Quality initiatives, Quality sustenance and Quality enhancement. The assessment is based on online data and onsite visit observations and through facts and figures about various aspects of the institutional functioning

She stressed on the need for colleges to go for A&A. It shall be mandatory for all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to get accredited by an agency like NAAC failing which institutions will not be eligible for financial assistance from UGC.



Dr. N.L. Bhirud, Dean Academics, Sandip Foundation of Engineering & Management, Nashik, guided on Course file Preparation such as courses require careful planning and continual revision. Consult with colleagues who have taught the same or similar courses to learn from their strategies and their general impressions of the students who typically take the course. If you are team-teaching, you and your teaching partner(s) should begin meeting well in advance to discuss course goals, teaching philosophies, course content, teaching methods, and course policies, as well as specific responsibilities for each faculty.

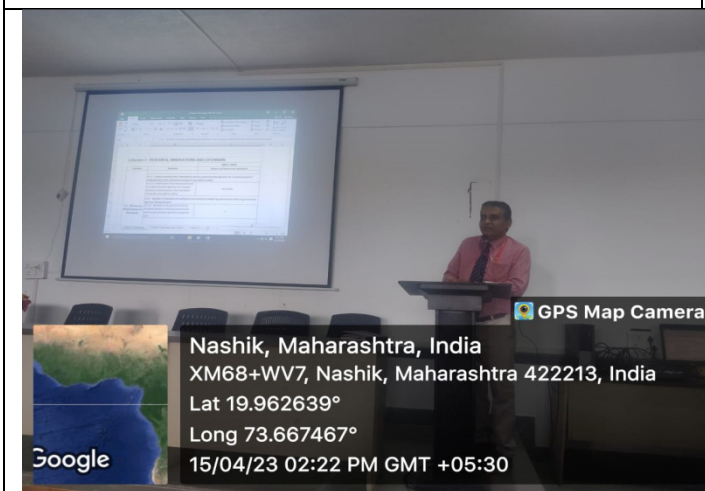
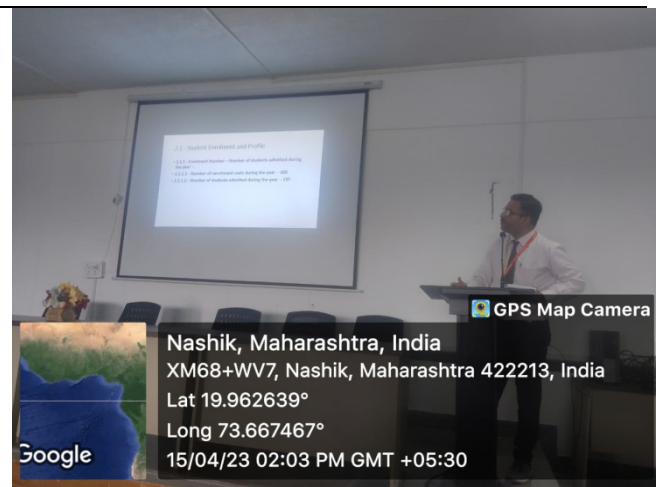
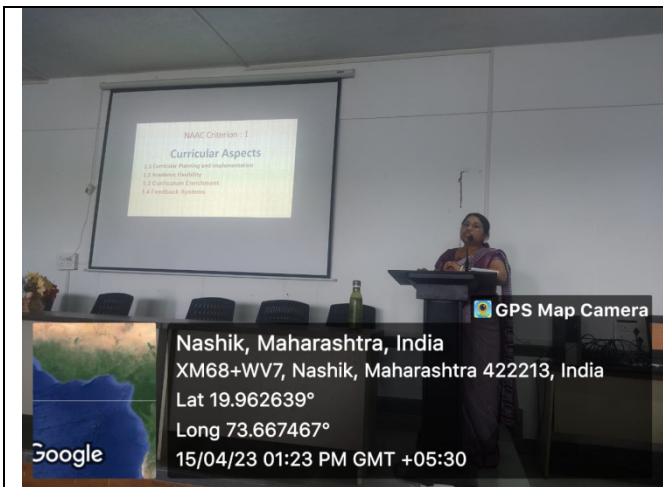


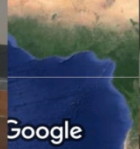
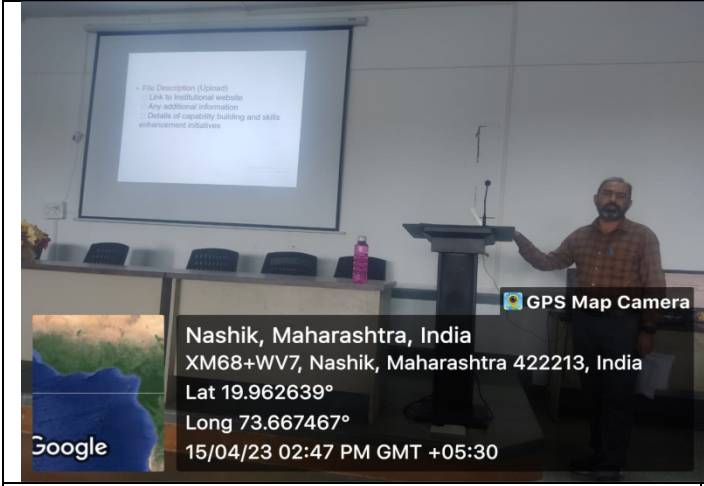

A questionnaire was designed for this purpose and the average response of the outgoing students for each PO is computed. Program outcomes attained through the attainment of COs. For a given course, all COs are mapped to certain Pos.



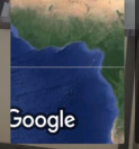
Each Criteria Coordinator gave detailed description of criteria wise Submission & requirements that the college must undertake.

- Dr. R.T. Pardeshi - Criteria: 7 – Institutional values and Best Practices

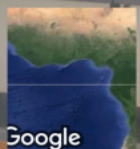
