## **Summary:**

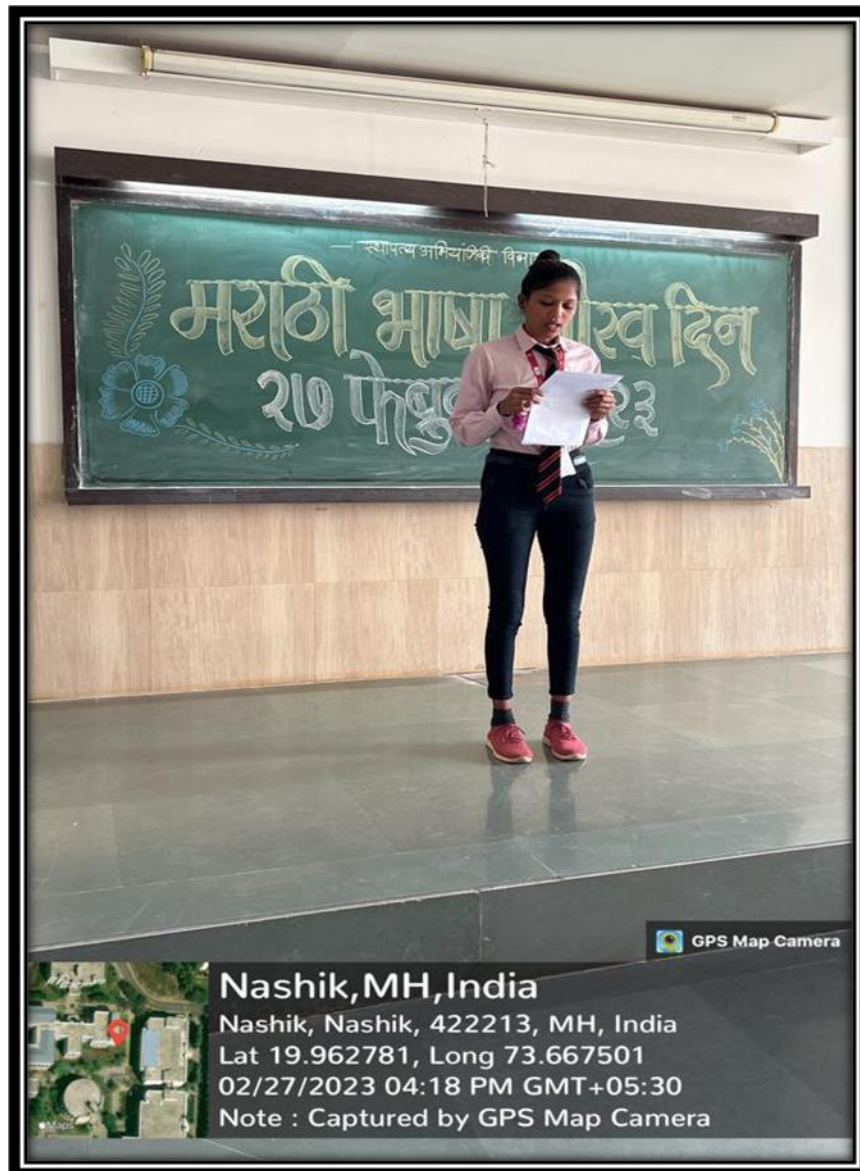
1. The program was start with Ganesh Puja.
