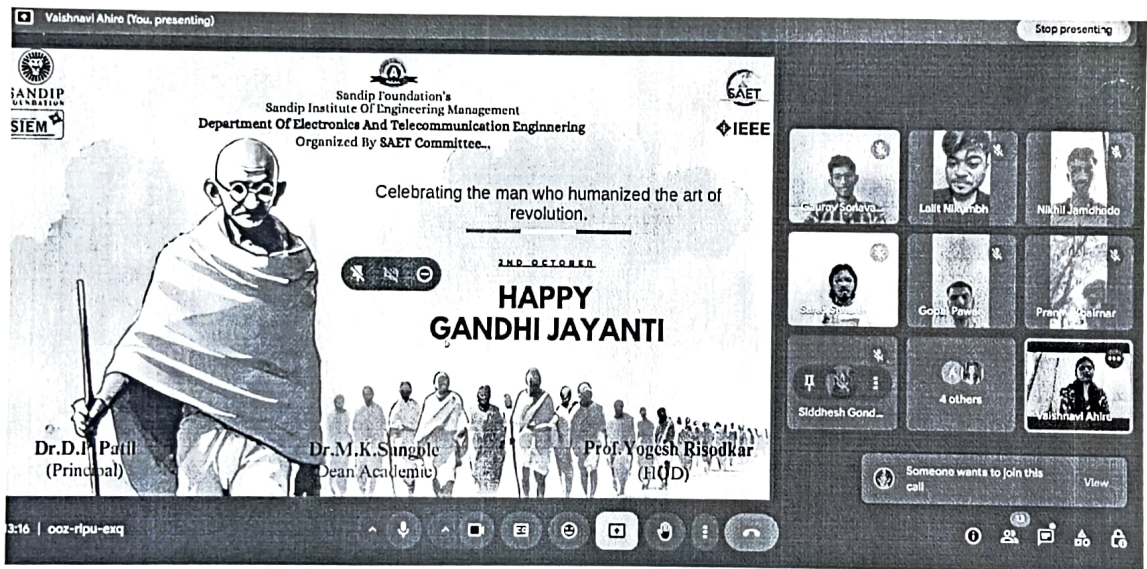
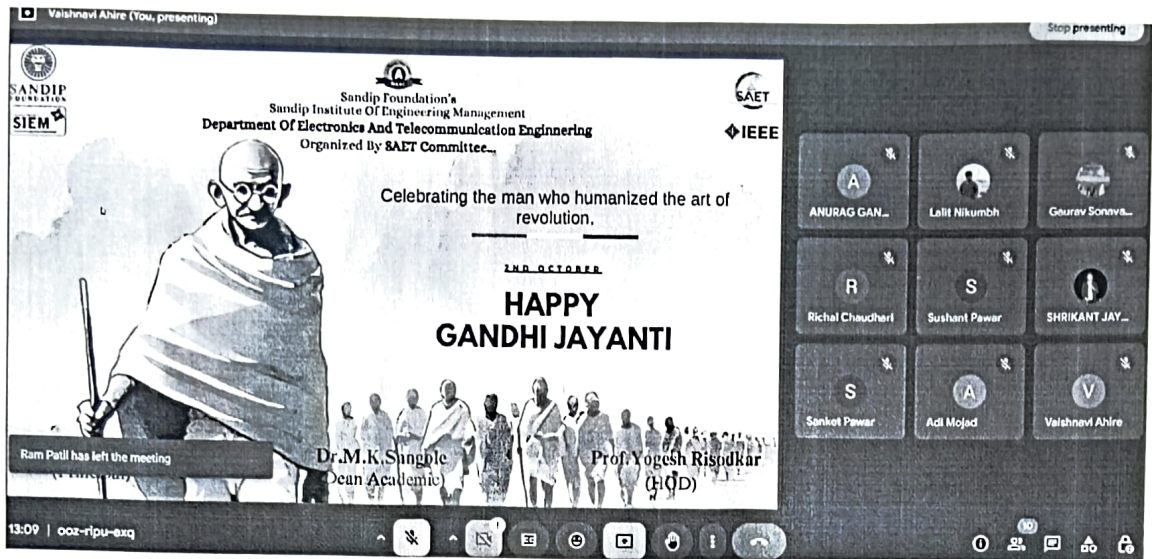


By commemorating Gandhi's birthday, individuals and organizations aim to keep alive his teachings and inspire action toward a more just and peaceful world.
